

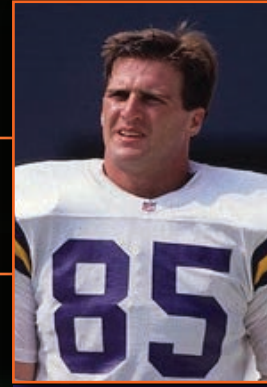

Raised in Skokie, Novoselsky graduated from Niles North High School where he earned all-conference honors in football and baseball. He was an outstanding tight end for Penn in the mid-1980s before playing seven years in the National Football League.

In 1986, he was named All-Ivy League first team as he led the Quakers in receiving with 18 catches for 337 yards and six touchdowns.

After graduating in 1988, Novoselsky joined the Chicago Bears for that season; he played in eight games but had no receptions. In 1989, he joined the Minnesota Vikings and played in 78 out of a possible 80 regular season games for the Vikings. He suffered a career-ending neck injury during a game against the Tampa Bay Buccaneers that initially left him with no feeling in his arms and legs.

Surviving a period he called the "worst five weeks of his life" following spinal surgery, Novoselsky experienced wildly mixed emotions as he adjusted to life after professional football.

Novoselsky is currently Vice President of Wealth Management for GCG Financial where he has worked and built client relationships since 1995.

He is a member of the Chicago Jewish Sports Hall of Fame.
